HABITAT FOR HUMANITY CAN HOUSE NEWS

- Please deposit only aluminum cans and pie tins. Soup/bean/veggie cans are made of steel and tin and are not accepted.
- It would be VERY helpful to have the cans crushed before leaving them in the Can House. Not only does crushing keep the mass to a minimum, but it is also a great release of stress and anger!

Help Wanted: A volunteer is needed to bag the cans and take them to the BRC Recycling Center (off of Campbell Avenue). Usually only one trip per month is necessary. 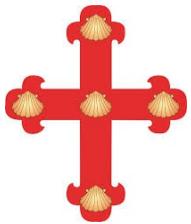
